Proposals sought for the 2022 SWFL TESOL Conference

We encourage K-12 and adult education classroom teachers, researchers, administrators, and higher education faculty to submit proposals.

General Requirements:

- Submissions must be received by December 22, 2021.
- Acceptances and notifications will be communicated on/about January 15, 2022.
- Presenters must register by February 1, 2022 to be included in the program. Registration information will be communicated with a notification letter.
- A computer with Internet access, projector, and screen will be available in each session room.

Title: (12-word limit)

Presentation Types:

- Workshop Session (interactive, practice-oriented) (45 min.)
- Research Presentation (20 min)

Abstract: (300-word limit)

- Clearly state a purpose and point of view
- Include supporting details and examples
- Contain evidence of current practices and/or research connected to conference theme

Proposal Summary: (100-word limit) This will be used in the program. Please proofread your submission.

Presenter's Information: Please provide the following contact information: name(s), title(s), address(es), telephone number(s), institutional affiliation(s), and email address(es).

Presenter's Bio: (50-word limit)

Selection Criteria: Proposals will be selected based on clarity, timeliness of topic, relevance to theme and audience, and positive contribution to the conference and the TESOL field.

Responsibilities of the Presenter:

- The presenter listed first is responsible for notifying the co-presenters of the status of the proposal and any other notifications received.
- The conceptual content of a proposal cannot be changed once it has been accepted.
- Presenters will be asked to provide links and/or handouts to participants.
- All presenters are expected to register as conference attendees by February 1st and to participate in all conference activities.
- Presenters are responsible for their own travel costs. Hotel group rate information will be posted on our website: swfltesol.org
